Swimming Pool Repairs

Work started over February half term with a scaffolding cover erected over the pool to allow work to continue throughout the unfavourable weather. The pool tank has now been sandblasted, repaired where needed and prepped for tiling which took ten days followed by four days of grouting. The old boiler is now disconnected with pipework replaced in the plant room in order to link up to

the eco-friendly air heat source pumps. The tank will now be filled leading to the pool work completed by 23rd April. The pool work has all been carried out thanks to the grant received from East Dorset District Council and Councillor Gorringer, Bluewater Pools and suppliers who offered us discounted rates, and of course the monies raised by you the parents.
